The amendments include the addition or amendment of provisions addressing: the proper recording of certain payments and gifts to third parties in Section 12, required reporting of anticipated violations of the Code of Conduct in Section 14, responding to governmental or internal investigations in Section 15, waivers of the Code of Conduct in Section 16, enforcement of the Code of Conduct in Section 17 and a number of additional non-substantive changes.
